I will Redeem You with an Outstretched Arm

The holy day, Pesach (Passover), announces the arrival of spring on the Jewish calendar. Its importance to the biblical plan can be seen in the timing of the festival.

The meaning of Passover is found in Leviticus 23. This is a historical reference to God's deliverance of Israel from the bondage of Egypt as recorded in Exodus.

With every judgment of God there is also a way of escape. Any household that put the blood of the sacrificial lamb on its doorpost was given a special promise: "...when I see the blood, I will pass over you. No destructive plague will touch you..." (Exodus 12:13).



Passover clearly typifies redemption in a dramatic way. It is a holy day commemorating God's deliverance of Israel from the slavery of Egypt. Yet Pesach also holds a greater prophetic picture of God's plan for world redemption.

Among the traditional items mentioned are the lamb (Luke 22:8), bitter herbs (Matthew 26:23), the washings (John 13: 1-15), the four cups of wine (Matthew 26 and Luke 22) and matzah (Matthew 26:26). The lamb reminds one of the means of redemption, the blood of the sacrifice. In this case, Messiah became our Pesach (John 1:29). The bitter herbs speak of terrible bondage to an oppressor. Not surprisingly, it was in the bowl of bitter herbs that Judas, a man who came to a bitter end, dipped his matzah. The hand and foot washings typify the need for cleansing before approaching a holy God.



Major Car Bombing Averted at Israeli Mall: Tragedy was prevented in the Israel port city of Haifa when explosives packed into a parked car at a local mall failed to go off. The bomb was discovered after security guards heard a small explosion and called police sappers to check out a suspicious vehicle. It was then discovered the car was loaded with close to 90 pounds of explosives – enough to have collapsed the entire three-story shopping mall.

EU Threatens Netanyahu Over PA State: The European Union (EU) issued an oblique threat to the incoming government of Prime Minister-designate Binyamin Netanyahu over the issue of a new Palestinian Authority (PA) state. EU foreign policy Chief Javier Solana told reporters that the European body of nations would change its relationship significantly with the Jewish State if the Netanyahu government does not back the establishment of a new Arab state within Israel's current borders.

PA's Fatah Violates Roadmap Demand to Recognize Israel: Senior Fatah leader Mohammed Dahlan confirmed on that Fatah, which leads the Palestinian Authority, does not recognize Israel, one of the basic demands of the Roadmap plan. The Western world has boycotted the Hamas terrorist organization because of the same refusal to acknowledge the existence of the Jewish state. The other two requirements in the American-backed Roadmap plan - renouncing violence and accepting existing agreements - also have been violated by the PA. "I want to say for the thousandth time, in my own name and in the name of all of my fellow members of the Fatah movement: We do not demand that the Hamas movement recognize Israel," Dahlan said on PA television. "On the contrary, we demand of the Hamas movement not to recognize Israel because the Fatah movement does not recognize Israel even today, added Dahlan. He was Fatah's top official in the Gaza region until Hamas won a militia war against the rival sect nearly 2 years ago.

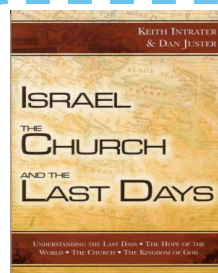
Plant a Tree in Israel
