Merry Christmas and Happy Hanukkah

This year is about over and most of us are getting ready for the winter holidays. Christians will be celebrating the birth of the Messiah on December the 25th, and the Jewish people will be observing the eight days of Hanukkah. Hanukkah this year begins on the 24th day in the month of Kislev in Jewish Calendar, which this year begins at sundown on December 22nd, and runs until December 29th, 2019. It's always exciting when both celebrations coincide and we are able to share the joy of our Messiah's birth and the miracle of the Feast of Lights.

Most everybody knows about Christmas (the day chosen to celebrate the birth of our Messiah), but most know very little about Hanukkah (the Biblical Feast of Dedication, ***John 10:22***).

Hanukkah, as you probably remember, was a time in which the Temple was rededicated to God after the Assyrians (representing things of the world) had totally desecrated it. During this celebration we light the Hanukkah Menorah for eight nights to commemorate the fact that God performed a miracle, by allowing one day of oil to provide light for eight days.

Since the Temple in Jerusalem was destroyed back in 70 CE, we know God can't dwell where there is sin, and many of our lives are cluttered with guilt and sin. God said, ***“I am Holy so you be Holy.”*** the Bible tells us that His followers (***true believers in Messiah Yeshua***) are now the Temple of God and have been established as His Holy dwelling place.

This is why Hanukkah (***the Feast of Dedication***), needs to be an important part of our lifestyle today.

Statistics show us that during the holiday season there are more suicides, and more cases of depression and despair than any other time of the year. So why would this time of Dedication (***Hanukkah***), this time of acknowledging the Messiah's miraculous birth (***Christmas***), and this time of celebrating a new beginning (secular New Year), be such a downer? Israeli Updates

GAZA TERRORISTS FIRE ROCKETS INTO ISRAEL AFTER ISLAMIC JIHAD LEADER KILLED:

Gaza fired at least 160 rockets into Israel by mid-afternoon on Tues. 12 Nov. 2019, setting off sirens and forcing people into bomb shelters across the country including in Tel Aviv, after Israel's military killed a senior leader of the second-largest terrorist group in the Palestinian territory. Israeli authorities reported at least two injuries in Israel from the rockets, including an 8-year-old girl who is in critical condition after losing consciousness while running to a bomb shelter. Israeli military spokesman Lt. Col. Jonathan Conricus said Mr. Abu Al-Ata was a "ticking bomb," who was planning an attack that included sniper fire, IEDs and ground units against Israeli soldiers and possibly civilians. "We have been looking for the opportune moment for a week. We were waiting for when he was not surrounded by human shields," Conricus said. "The response to this crime will have no limits," Islamic Jihad said in a statement, referring to Abu Al-Ata's killing.

IRAN DISPLAYS NEW HATE MURALS ON WALLS OF USA FORMER EMBASSY: Lest there be any doubt as to the Islamic Republic's sentiments towards the USA, Iran last weekend unveiled new anti-American murals on the walls of the former USA embassy. The accusatory message of the artwork is one of the blood-thirsty USA eager for war and bent on tightening its grip on the world, yet weakening despite its military might. The new murals were painted in white, red and blue, the colors of the USA. One of them showed a crumbling Statue of Liberty, its right torch-bearing arm having broken off. Another depicted the triangle of the Eye of Providence, the symbol used on the back of the USA dollar bill, in a sea of blood in which skulls are floating. A third showed the American Global Hawk drone that was shot down by Iran in June 2019 over the Strait of Hormuz, with bats flying out of it. Tehran prepared to mark on Mon. 4 Nov. 2019 the 40th anniversary of the hostage crisis, an act that continues to poison Iran-USA relations. On 4 Nov. 1979, less than nine months after the toppling of Iran's American-backed shah, students overran the complex to demand the United States hand over the ousted ruler after he was admitted to an American hospital. It took 444 days for the crisis to end with the release of 52 Americans. The USA broke off diplomatic relations with Iran in 1980.

NETANYAHU: ISRAEL IS THE REASON IRAN DOESN'T HAVE NUCLEAR WEAPONS: PM Benjamin Netanyahu reiterated this week that Israel is committed to keeping Iran from embedding itself militarily on the nation's borders. "We have one main goal and that is to make sure that Iran does not develop nuclear weapons and that its march toward an empire and conquest has stopped," Netanyahu told a crowd of more than 200 people at the kick-off event of the Christian Media Summit. Netanyahu added that President Donald Trump's "maximum economic pressure on Iran is having an effect." The prime minister also noted that "if it was not for Israel, Iran would already have obtained nuclear weapons."

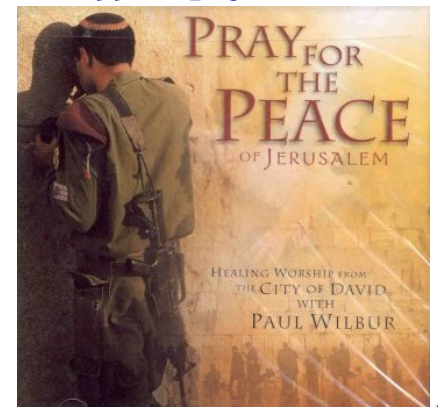

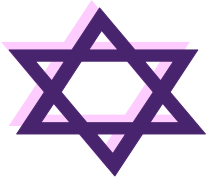
