“The Deal of the Century” At what Cost?

With rumors of President Donald Trump's “Deal of the Century” being unveiled within the next month or two, we are already seeing statements from both sides declaring what they will and will not accept in the peace deal. But does it really matter about the details of the agreement?

Though history we learn that Israel will agree to just about any conditions for the chance to be able to live in peace and safety in their own land and to have a normal life.

On the other side we know that the leaders of the Palestinian Arabs will not abide by the agreement, even if they did by some chance agree to the peace plan.

While waiting upon the details of the peace agreement, one thing seems apparent. The closer we get to the unveiling of “The Deal of the Century”, the terrace attacks on Israel escalations. It starts with a protest then it progresses to kits with firebombs designed to set fire to farmlands and destroy forests, and it builds up to just over a couple of weeks ago we saw over seven hundred rockets launched into Israel, and the cost starts adding up with Israeli lives.

This is not the first time, everyone who lived in Israel in the mid-90s remembers the wave of suicide terror attacks in the two years between September 1993 until the accords were signed in September 1995, the cost was 164 Israeli lives.

And a few years later, when the peace talks with the Palestinians at Camp David reached a dead end in July 2000, the result was the Second Intifada. This uprising was deadlier than the first, and claimed the lives of more than 500 Israelis alone in the 18 months between the start of the Intifada and Operation Defensive Shield in Passover 2002.

Ehud Barak, who was prime minister during the Camp David summit, once said that the failure of peace negotiations exposed the true nature of the Palestinians.

(Ezekiel 37:26) Moreover I will make a covenant of peace with them; it shall be an everlasting covenant with them: and I will place them, and multiply them, and will set my sanctuary in the midst of them for evermore.

Israeli Updates → **DODGING MISSILES ON SUNDAY, DANCING IN THE STREETS ON THURSDAY:**

On Sunday 5 May 2019 hundreds of rockets pounded southern Israel. Four Israelis were killed by indiscriminate rocket fire. Residents of communities around Gaza were worried about whether they would be able to shepherd their children into bomb shelters in under 20 seconds. Later in the week, on Independence Day, the country's mood was light and carefree. The ability to shift from a near war footing one day to a country that feels at ease the next is one of the secrets of Israel's success. It is the power to move on and not be paralyzed by fear or grief or pain or a sense of victimhood. It's called resilience. Thursday's 9 May 2019 picnics in the forests, the parties on the beaches, the thanksgiving prayers in the synagogues and the visits to army installations, all those routine acts the Jewish people of Israel perform on Independence Day, took on a bit more meaning this year, coming - as they did - mere days after the most recent attempt by Israel's enemies to shut down the Zionist enterprise.

ISRAEL IS A SUPERPOWER OF HOPE: PM Benjamin Netanyahu published an Independence Day message in English on his YouTube channel. He wrote that "more and more people around the world see the truth about Israel's achievements, about our freedom, about our hope. We are the only people who live in the same land, with the same name, speak the same language and have the same faith as we had 3,000 years ago," he added. Also on Thur. Israel's President Reuven Rivlin hosted a reception for the diplomatic and consular corps in honor of Israel's 71st Independence Day. "It is a pleasure to welcome you to this celebration of our seventy-first Independence Day, in our three-thousand-year-old capital of Jerusalem," said the president at the beginning of his remarks. "From the day Israel was born until today, we have faced enemies. Yet despite the severe security threats, we have built a thriving democracy with an independent judiciary, a free press, and religious freedom for all. This is a modern miracle," he said. "Israel is a small country, but we have big dreams. In fact, we are already becoming a world superpower. Not a superpower of military might - though we will always do what is necessary to defend ourselves - but a superpower of hope. Hope for a better future for all humanity. Israeli technologies are already improving the lives of people around the world in the fields of clean water, sustainable farming, green energy, and medical aid.

"Now imagine how these technologies could improve lives throughout the Middle East," he said. "We continue to dream of peace with all our neighbors, because I deeply believe that we are not doomed to live together, we are destined to live together. Together we can build a better future for all the peoples of the region," he concluded. During the day, the official presidential residence received messages of congratulations from many world leaders. Among them were President Donald J. Trump and President Vladimir Putin. Notes of congratulations were also received from Federal President Frank-Walter Steinmeier, Queen Elizabeth II and many other global leaders.

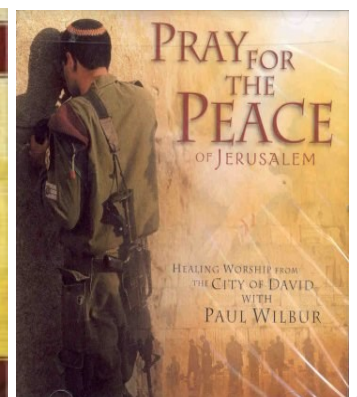
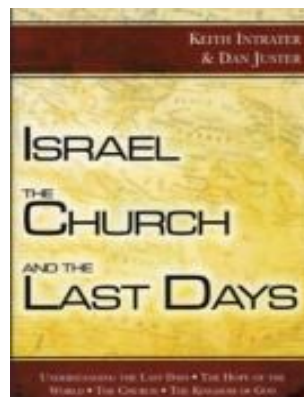

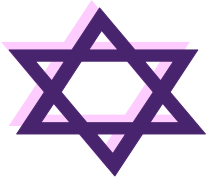
