Blessing or Curses? Your Choice

As being a part of Yachad Ministries for almost 25 years, and going into all different Churches and different denominations, and we meet people with a wide variety of opinions on the row that the land of Israel and / or the Jewish people plays in the future. The question is this: does it matter if the Jewish people live in the land of Israel - Judea, Samaria, Jerusalem, or some where else?

If we can believe that God spoke a physical universe into existence, why can't we believe God spoke a future Israel into existence through a covenant (promise)? In **(Genesis 12)**, God says to Abraham, **"This is the (physical) land I will give your descendants."**

The prophet **(Jeremiah 23:7-8)** declares, **"Therefore, behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that they shall no more say, The LORD liveth, which brought up the children of Israel out of the land of Egypt;" But, The LORD liveth, which brought up and which led the seed of the house of Israel out of the north country, and from all countries whither I had driven them; and they shall dwell in their own land.**

Too often when we study prophecies in the Bible we focus on the negative parts, but when we read the positive prophecies, one thing is very clear: God loves Israel and the Jewish people, but when you say Israel and the Jews are His choosing people, sometimes people gets a little offended, they don't realizing by standing with His people, that they too could come and experience the same blessings. **(Galatians 3:29) And if ye be Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.** You also hear us talk about mostly the first part of **(Genesis 12:3) (And I will bless them that bless thee,)** but what about the second part? **(and curse him that curseth thee: and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed).** We don't realize that the nations who attack Israel, or just stand by and do nothing, will be judged by God.

In **(Deuteronomy 23:3,4)** it says **"An Ammonite or Moabite shall not enter the assembly of the LORD; even to the tenth generation none of his descendants shall enter the assembly of the LORD forever, because they did not meet you with bread and water on the road when you came out of Egypt, and because they hired against you Balaam the son of Beor from Pethor of Mesopotamia, to curse you."**

The punishment God given to Ammonites and Moabites was that they were not allowed to enter the "Assembly of the LORD." When we think of the Assembly of the LORD or Assembly of God, we think about the building we worship in every week. The Assembly of the LORD in the Bible was the gathering place for all the children of Israel or all the children of the God of Israel. The Assembly of the LORD is what many of the Psalmists wrote about. For example, **"One day in your courts (the Assembly of the LORD) is better than a thousand outside."** **(Psalms 84:10)**

But why were they punished? Because they did not give bread and water or sustenance when the children of Israel were on the journey to the Promised Land. It look like there was an expectation of God for the Gentiles to help Israel as they move toward its Promised Land. Wait, didn't God provide bread and water to the Israelites in the desert? Why would God ask the Gentiles to provide something He is already providing? The question should be, which would have been the bigger miracle, provision coming from the nations or complete provision by the hand of God?

Israeli Updates → **EU Ambassadors: 'We Won't Stand Idly When Israel's Right to Exist is Questioned'**; The Delegation of the European Union to the State of Israel on

Monday, paid tribute to those who perished in the Holocaust and those who fought the Nazis. In the statement, the delegation said, "We, representatives of the European Union and of the 26 Embassies of EU Member States present in Israel, are bowing our heads today in memory of the six million Jewish men, women and children who were brutally slaughtered during the Holocaust." "The history of the Holocaust constantly reminds us that we cannot remain indifferent to violence fueled by hatred of any nation or group. Any ideology that deprives certain individuals of their human dignity and rights must be met with our unanimous condemnation." The statement added, "We pledge to speak out forcefully whenever and wherever antisemitism rises. It is unacceptable that today the hatred of Jews is once again on the march. We will not stand idly by when Jews are being attacked or harassed, when false conspiracy theories and stereotypes are spread, when the Holocaust is denied or distorted, when the State of Israel's right to exist in peace and security is questioned." "Words are not enough. The European Union's Comprehensive Strategy on Combating Anti-Semitism and Fostering Jewish Life (2021-2030) lists 95 concrete actions we will take. More than half have already been set in motion."

Iran Will Destroy Tel Aviv, Haifa at Slightest Israeli Action – Raisi; Iranian President Ebrahim Raisi threatened to destroy Tel Aviv and Haifa at the slightest provocation in a speech he delivered during the country's National Army Day parade that also fell on Israel's Holocaust Remembrance Day. "The slightest mistake against our country will be responded with a harsh response and will be accompanied by the destruction of Haifa and Tel Aviv," Raisi said according to an English language translation of his speech posted on his office's web page. "The enemies of the Islamic Revolution, especially the Zionist Regime, have received the message of the power of the armed forces of the Islamic Republic of Iran," he explained. Raisi also called on United States forces to leave the Middle East stating: extra-regional forces, especially American forces, should leave the region as soon as possible because they threaten the security of the region and have not and will not provide security for the nations of the region. He stressed that it was the forces of the Islamic Republic that provided stability to the region. He spoke amid rising tensions between Israel and the Islamic Republic, as the IDF has struck at Iranian-based targets and Tehran is believed to be behind the rocket fire by Hamas against Israel's southern and northern border earlier this month.


