Shavuot - The Feast of Weeks

Over two thousand years ago at this time of year, people were crowding into a small town called Jerusalem for the annual celebration of Shavuot. Thousands of people from all over the world were there because God commanded that on three different occasions each year, the Jewish people should come to Jerusalem to worship God in person. However this particular year, something was different. Just a little over a month and a half before, a man named Yeshua (Jesus) from Galilee was executed the day before Passover and many say that after three days and nights in the grave, God resurrected Him from the dead on the Feast of First Fruits. Some even say He was the Jewish Messiah of the Bible. All we know is that at the time people were still talking, and maybe even wondering, who was this man that thousands of people saw do miracles.

There where a hundred and twenty Jewish people, including twelve of Yeshua's closest disciples, were meeting in an upper room in Jerusalem because Yeshua had told them not to leave the city until a Comforter came into their lives. He told them that the Spirit of God had been with them, but that soon He would come and dwell within them. There they were, all of one mind, praying just like the prophets of old. All of a sudden, a mighty wind blew through the room, and something like the flames of a fire settled on each one of them and they were filled with the Holy Spirit.

Each one of them began speaking in different languages and testifying about Yeshua and His atoning blood. Now thousands of these devoted Jewish men, that had come from every nation under heaven were hearing this message in their own language and these words changed their hearts, and in one day adding three thousand Jewish people to the original hundred and twenty believers. The next day another five thousand more were added.



Can you imagine experiencing Shavuot this particular year? A hundred and twenty believers turn into probably ten thousand in a matter of at most a few days. We know that thousands of these devoted Jewish men went back to their homes and their synagogues all across to the four corners of the earth, and the Shavuot message of great hope they returned home with was powered by the Holy Spirit. I wonder how many believers there were by the time of the High Holy Days. All we know is that by the end of the first century, it is estimated that there were about a million and a half born-again Jewish people, not to mention all the gentiles that by this time were being saved. It's amazing how all this took place because one hundred and twenty Jewish believers were obedient to Yeshua, not to mention the thousands of devoted people who just came to Jerusalem because they were supposed to.

The theme of Shavuot can be best summed up by the word revival. Israel was called to praise God for the first fruits of the ground, by doing this they knew that these early fruits assured the latter harvest. This also applies to the spiritual Kingdom of God. The first fruits of believers at Shavuot virtually guarantees a revival in the latter-day spiritual harvest for God through the Messiah.

Israeli Updates Scientists Discover Hidden Bible Chapter Written 1,500 Years Ago by Using UV Light - Inside the Vatican Library; Scientists have found a 'hidden chapter' of Bible text written more than 1,500 years ago. The page features chapters 11 through 12 from Matthew, providing more details than today's standard Gospel text. Scientists uncovered the scripture after applying ultraviolet light to a manuscript about ancient Christian stories and hymns housed at the Vatican Library. The researchers have not yet revealed a complete translation written in ancient Syriac, but shared some details. In the Greek version of Matthew chapter 12, verse one reads: 'At that time Jesus went through the grain fields on the Sabbath and his disciples became hungry and began to pick the heads of grain and eat.' The Syriac translation reads, '[...] began to pick the heads of grain, rub them in their hands, and eat them.' The initial text was written around the third century but was erased by a scribe in Palestine - a common practice because the paper made from animal skin was scarce. Palimpsest Grigory Kessel, who made the discovery, told British media: "The Gospel text found in this reused manuscript contains the so-called Old Syriac translations of the Gospels. This Old Syriac translation quite often attests the Gospel text that is different from the standard Gospel text as we know it today." UV light has become popular among scientists who hope to uncover secret documents, as the hidden text absorbs the light and glows blue. It can capture hidden text because parchment soaks in ink. And no matter how often it is reused, the original writings are still imprinted on the paper. "The Gospel text is hidden in the sense that the early 6th c. parchment copy of the Gospels Book was reused twice and today on the same page one can find three layers of writing (Syriac - Greek - Georgian)," Kessel said.

Israel Must Prepare for War with Iran without US Help, Former NSA Chief Says; Former national security adviser Yaakov Amidror said Thursday, that war with Iran is increasingly likely and Israel needs to gear up to attack without US assistance. "We need to prepare for war. It's possible that we will reach a point where we have to attack Iran even without American assistance," Amidror, a hawkish former general who served as Nation Security Council chief under Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu from 2011-2013, said in an interview. Amidror was discussing a flare-up over the Passover holiday that saw rockets fired at Israel from Gaza, Lebanon, and Syria by groups largely seen as Iranian proxies. "Iran is more sure of itself. It has managed to sign a number of agreements with Arab states. The world is starting to look different," he said, referring to the recent agreements by the UAE and Saudi Arabia to restore diplomatic ties with Tehran. He also questioned the US commitment to Israel's security. "America is not the same America in terms of its presence, and the Iranians see that. The US has much greater problems than the Middle East. The world looks at Israel differently," he said. Amidror's statements come despite repeated US declarations it is committed to Israel's security and a recent show of force two weeks ago when it broke protocol and announced that it had dispatched a nuclear-powered guided-missile submarine to the Middle East to "help ensure regional maritime security and stability" amid increasing tensions with Iran.
