SHAVUOT (PENTECOST)(THE DAY OF THE GIVING OF THE LAW)

THE HISTORICAL BACKGROUND From the day after the Sabbath, the day you brought the sheaf of the wave offering, count off seven full weeks. Count off fifty days up to the day after the seventh Sabbath, and then present an offering of new grain to the Lord. (**Leviticus 23:15-21**)

TRADITIONAL JEWISH OBSERVANCE Traditional Jewish observance of Shavuot is multi-faceted, and has evolved somewhat from biblical times. As recorded in the Torah, biblical observance centered around grain and animal offerings. Part of the wheat offering was baked into two loaves of leavened bread, a striking contrast to the matzah a few weeks before. Leaven symbolically represents sin. These two loaves were brought into the Temple and, with great ceremony, waved in every direction before the Lord. This act was a public statement of God. "Provision for all his people" (**Mishna Bikkurim 3:2**).

NEW TESTAMENT OBSERVANCE This festival is mentioned a number of times in the New Testament. Rabbi Saul of Tarsus planned his travels in correlation with Shavuot (**I Corinthians 16:8**). The most famous record of this holy day appears in the book of Acts.

THE PROPHETIC FULFILLMENT This synchronizes with promises in Scripture of latter-day messianic Jewish revival. Increasing numbers of Jewish people will believe in Yeshua until in the final day "all Israel will be saved" (**Romans II :26**). I personally believe that the growing revival among Jews believing in the Messiah today indicates that we are drawing close to that time. The explosive growth of the messianic Jewish movement testifies to this modern reality. **Acts 2** reveals amazing details confirming the Jewish background of this New Testament Pentecost. **Ezekiel I** is the traditional reading from the prophets for Shavuot. This passage dramatically describes Ezekiel's vision of the glory of God. He describes the tremendous manifestation in these terms.

A PRACTICAL GUIDE FOR BELIEVERS IN MESSIAH With all the spiritual meaning behind the holy day of Shavuot, believers in Yeshua can find great blessing in celebrating it. Much of the traditional Jewish observance can be followed. Yet, as believers add messianic perspective to this feast, it becomes more meaningful. The practical celebration of Shavuot begins when Sfirat Haomer ends. On the day before the start of Pentecost. A number of preparations should be made for the observance. The dinner table is set with the best linens and dishes. You may want to decorate the house with greenery or fresh flowers, a reminder of the harvest aspect of the day. As the sun is setting on Erev Shavuot (evening of Pentecost), the family and friends gather around the festive table. The holiday candles are lit and the following blessings are recited.

The theme of Shavuot can be best summed up by the word revival. Israel was called to praise God for the first fruits of the ground, knowing that these early fruits assured the latter harvest. This also applies to the spiritual Kingdom of God. The first fruits of believers at Shavuot virtually guarantees a revival in the latter-day spiritual harvest for Messiah. Now we can understand why God included Shavuot in the three required festivals for every Jewish male. As Passover speaks of redemption, Shavuot speaks of revival, especially during this era. The message of Shavuot is one of great hope and joy. May the day come soon when the holy spirit will be poured out upon the house of David, and they will all look, in faith, to the one who was pierced (**Zechariah 12: 10**).

Israeli Updates

ISRAELI HOSPITALS TREAT THOUSANDS OF ARABS - WHERE'S THE MEDIA COVERAGE?

No further evidence is necessary of the mainstream media's anti-Israel bias than its total lack of coverage of the fact that Israeli hospitals routinely treat Arab patients from all over the Middle East. Instead, the media paints Israel as a bigoted society that only wishes ill on its Arab foes. A recent Israeli media report disclosed what's going on at just one Israeli hospital. In cooperation with the Israeli NGO "Save a Child's Heart," Wolfson Medical Center in the central Israel town of Holon has treated thousands of Arabs in recent years. Most of the patients have been Palestinian Arab children in need of life-saving surgery, which is fully covered by "Save a Child's Heart" and the Israeli taxpayers. Many other patients have come from war-torn Iraq. Others have from as far away as Afghanistan. In one instance, a princess from the emirate of Bahrain insisted on having critical surgery in Israel, insisting that only in the Jewish state would she receive the treatment needed to save her life. Isn't that curious? After all, Israel's antagonists suggest that an Arab who falls into the Jewish state's hands is more likely than not to lose his life. They say Israel is a nation of "child-killers." But here these Israelis are, not killing, but saving the lives of thousands of Arab children. And the media is silent.

LONDONISTAN: 500 CLOSED CHURCHES, 423 NEW MOSQUES: The city of London now has 423 new mosques, which are "built on the sad ruins of English Christianity." So writes Italian journalist and writer, Giulio Meotti. The Hyatt United Church, for instance, on Hamilton Road, was purchased by the Egyptian community and is being converted into a mosque. St Peter's Church is now the Madina Mosque, and the Brick Lane Mosque used to be a Methodist church. Not only buildings are converted, writes Meotti, but also people: "The number of converts to Islam in London has doubled; often they embrace radical Islam, as with Khalid Masood, the terrorist who struck Westminster. Given the current trends," he predicts, "Christianity in England is becoming a relic, while Islam will be the religion of the future." It is estimated that by 2020, the number of Muslims attending prayers will top the number of Christians attending weekly Mass, 683,000 to 679,000. Within a generation, the number of churchgoers will be three times lower than that of Muslims who go regularly to mosque on Friday. Demographically, Britain has been acquiring an increasingly Islamic face in many cities. Birmingham, England's 2nd largest city, has a population that is 21.8% Muslim; Manchester, stands at 15.8% Muslim, and Bradford, with well over 300,000 people, is a quarter Muslim, including half its children. In Leicester, too, Britain's 10th largest city, half the children are Muslim.

JEWISH PARENTS PULL SON FROM BERLIN SCHOOL OVER ANTI-SEMITISM: Allegations of anti-Semitic harassment of a Jewish student in Germany that forced him to leave his school have spurred demands for a federal investigation by Germany's top Jewish leader. The student's parents said they pulled their 14-year-old son from the Friedenauer Community School in March 2017, after four months of verbal and physical harassment, culminating in a brutal attack. The parents said the harassment came from students of Arab and Turkish background. In March, according to the parents, "he was attacked and almost strangled, and one of the pupils pulled a toy gun on him that looked like a real gun. And the whole crowd of kids laughed. He was completely shaken." Early on, when some pupils learned the boy was Jewish, one who had been friendly told him they couldn't be friends anymore because "Jews are all murderers." Josef Schuster, head of the Central Council of Jews in Germany, demanded that the education ministry investigate the incident and the response of the school, and state clearly where any failings might be. The school leadership said on its website that the alleged perpetrators in the incident would be held accountable.

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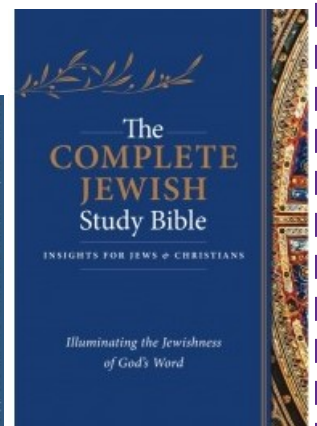
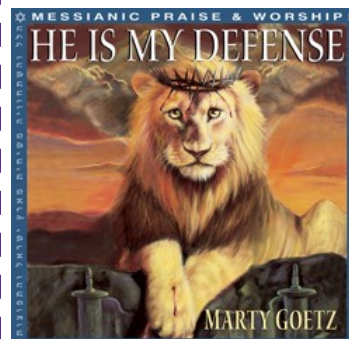
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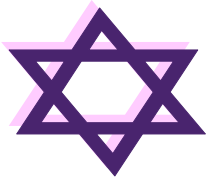
