Through the Eyes of a Jew

When you are Jewish, you are always aware that there is a large population in the world that wants to kill you. Even if they aren't trying now, you read history and you see that every few generations, at the very least, some group tries to kill all or at least a lot of Jewish people. We may like you saying “never again,” but we never fully believe it. On Saturday, October 7th, we were reminded that we were right not to. More Jews died in one day than any day since the Holocaust. And the reality is that while we felt shock, we didn't necessarily feel surprise.

After WWII, children would play a game called “hiding from the Nazis.” This wasn't hide and seek; they would just pick a place to hide, under a couch, behind a freezer, and just lie still for hours. They were genuinely “playing”; it was truly a game to them. But it's just to hammer home the point that Jewish children grow up with the Holocaust being a part of our history and an intrinsic understanding that at some point, we may need to hide again. “If you think you would have been one of the ones who hid Jews in WWII but are afraid of speaking up, you wouldn't have been.”

It's honestly a generally fair assessment because if you aren't the kind of person who can handle criticism for a non-conventional belief of any sort, you surely aren't the kind of person who would risk the Gestapo knocking on your door for hiding people. I've seen so many posts like this over the past 2 years. But... here is what your Jewish friends are wondering right now. So, why didn't you say something or post something this time? And that's not an accusatory, It's a genuine question. Because they need to know the answer.



Maybe you didn't say something or post something because you are ignorant about what took place. Maybe you didn't say something to your Jewish friends because you truly don't understand that every slaughtered baby, raped girl, and murdered man is consider to be one of their own family. Maybe you are so horrified by it all that you truly don't know what words to say. Maybe you are still wondering what to say. Well, it breaks my heart to tell you what your Jewish friends are wondering, they are wondering if you are safe, will you stand with them or will you stand against them? They are seeing many others cave to the propaganda from the Hamas apologists; they are seeing the pro-Hamas protests and the threats from all over the world, and they know that if you are too afraid to speak, then you would be too afraid to hide them.

The history of the Jewish people is not a light one. But it is filled with joy. Our victories have always risen above our tragedies. It is a history of suffering, but overcoming the suffering. And throughout history, there have always been those who stand with us. From the Egyptians who joined the Israelites, following the pillar of fire by day and cloud by night, to the hundreds of thousands of gentiles who put their lives on the line to hide Jews in Europe during the Second World War. Israeli Updates

Iran Ordered Hezbollah to Carry out Attacks on Israel's North – IDF;

Iran ordered Hezbollah to escalate against Israel on Sunday, IDF Spokesperson Brig. Gen. Daniel Hagari said in his Monday morning press conference. "If Hezbollah fails to understand us, the response will be deadly," said Hagari, repeating the sentence for emphasis. There has been an ongoing debate about whether Iran was involved more generally, with general training, funding, and logistics support, or with specific direction and responsibility for Hamas' invasion of the South on October 7, but Hagari was unambiguous about his accusation on Monday. Sirens were heard in western Galilee on Sunday afternoon close to the Lebanon border in the towns of Nahariya, Rosh Hanikra, Hanita, Gesher HaZiv, Betzet, and Shlomi. Hamas in Lebanon took responsibility for the rocket fire. A spokesperson for the Galilee Medical Center in Nahariya announced they received eight people who had been wounded by the rocket fire. The IDF responded by attacking military infrastructure in southern Lebanon with helicopters. Besides Hamas in Lebanon, there were also reports of Hezbollah firing systematically to destroy IDF border surveillance equipment to blind its early warning invasion capabilities, much as Hamas made sure to eliminate many IDF border surveillance capabilities as it was invading Israel's Gaza corridor. Earlier, on Friday, Israeli drones, artillery, and tanks struck targets in Lebanon after an apparent drone was intercepted, shots were fired at several military posts on the northern frontier and an explosion damaged the border security barrier, the Israel Defense Forces said. Further, Hezbollah took responsibility for the firing of anti-tank missiles at IDF outposts near the Lebanon border, killing one man and wounding four others. As a result, the IDF announced on Sunday the creation of a four-kilometer "security zone" on the border to prevent any non-residents from entering the area.

Israel Says Hamas Leader Yahya Sinwar Is Their Bin Laden and that IDF Won't Stop Hunting Him;

Israeli troops on Saturday, October 14, were hunting a Hamas commander described as Palestine's Osama bin Laden, vowing to find him wherever he was hiding and insisting his days were numbered. Yahya Sinwar, 60, is the current head of Hamas in the Gaza Strip. He has been arrested by Israel multiple times and spent 24 years in Israeli prisons: he was freed in 2011, as part of a prisoner swap in exchange for Israeli soldier Gilad Shalit. Sinwar is being held responsible for the murder of 1,400 Israelis in the October 7 attack. The U.S. death toll rose to 29, with 15 missing, believed to be held hostage inside Gaza. "Yahya Sinwar is the face of evil," said Lt. Col. Richard Hecht, a spokesman for the IDF. "He is the mastermind behind this, like bin Laden was. He built his career on murdering Palestinians when he understood they were collaborators. That's how he became known as the butcher of Khan Younis [in southern Gaza]." Hecht said that Israeli troops would not rest until he was found and killed. "That man and his whole team are in our sights. We will get to that man," he said, adding: "This could be long." Sinwar was designated a terrorist by the United States in 2015.


