PASSOVER (PESACH), AN APPOINTED TIME WITH GOD

The meaning of Passover is found in *Leviticus 23:5-8*, "**The Lord's Passover begins at twilight on the fourteenth day of the first month. On the fifteenth day of that month the Lord's Feast of Unleavened Bread begins; for seven days you must eat bread made without yeast. On the first day hold a sacred assembly and do no regular work. For seven days present an offering made to the Lord by fire. And on the seventh day hold a sacred assembly and do no regular work**".

The Hebrew word "Pesach" means "to spring, jump or pass over", hence the English name, Passover. This is a historical reference to God's deliverance of Israel from the bondage of Egypt as recorded in Exodus. Because of the increasing hardness of Pharaoh's heart, God had to send ten plagues to persuade the blinded leader to let Israel go. As devastating as the first nine plagues were, it wasn't until the tenth and final plague that Pharaoh submitted to the God of Israel. In this judgment, God said he would send the Angel of Death over the land of Egypt to take the firstborn boy of every household.

With every judgment of God there is also a way of escape. Any household that put the blood of the sacrificial lamb on its doorpost was given a special promise: **"...when I see the blood, I will pass over you. No destructive plague will touch you..." (Exodus 12:13).**

Passover clearly typifies redemption in a dramatic way. It is a holy day commemorating God's deliverance of Israel from slavery of Egypt. Yet Pesach also holds a greater prophetic picture of God's plan for world redemption.

This Year, **5784 (2024)** Passover season and the Feast of Unleavened Bread begins on **Monday March 22 (Nisan 14th)** at sundown with a day of preparation, which is also the same day of Yeshua's last supper.

Passover, an appointed time that God set aside by his Word thirty-five hundred years ago, and it is just as relevant today as it was two thousand years ago. The Passover season is to be an example of a sinless environment, a Holy time set aside from the world, to remind us of the salvation God has provided.

The Biblical Passover season of old (*Exodus 12:3 -13*) actually began on **Nisan 10th**, when the father of the household would go and get the lamb for sacrifice and take it home to live with his family until it would be sacrificed on the day of preparation (**Nisan 14th**). It was the day of preparation when Yeshua suffered as he was beaten and scourged just as Isaiah said he would in Isaiah the 53rd chapter. He experienced death by dying on the cross, and like the Passover lamb became atonement for sin, and our sins were washed away with Yeshua's own sinless blood. Three days and three nights after the day of preparation, He became the first fruit of the resurrection, **with much fruit to come**, that all of us might experience life from the dead. These things all took place between the day before the Sabbath of Unleavened Bread and the weekly Sabbath which ends at sundown on Friday. The last day of Unleavened Bread is **April the 29th (Out side of Israel April 30th)**. (**The first and the last day of the Feast of Unleavened Bread's are annual Sabbaths proclaimed by God, is to be kept forever.**)

Israeli Updates → **Terrorists Open Fire on Gazan Civilians Waiting for Aid;** The IDF

released exclusive footage of Palestinian Arab terrorists opening fire among Gazan civilians about an hour before a humanitarian aid convoy entered the area of South Zeytun in the Strip. The Gazan “ministry of health”, which is controlled by Hamas, claimed on Thursday night that it was the IDF that opened fire on the Gazans, killing at least 21 people, but the IDF said those allegations were false. A preliminary IDF investigation into the incident found that Gazan terrorists were, in fact, the ones who opened fire on the civilians waiting for the aid. “About an hour before the entry of the aid convoy last night, Palestinian gunmen were seen opening fire in the midst of a crowd of Gazan civilians. We emphasize that there was no opening of fire by IDF forces at the aid convoy in Kuwait Square,” the IDF Spokesperson’s Unit said on Friday. “The IDF is continuing to examine the incident while making strenuous efforts to bring humanitarian aid to the residents of the Gaza Strip, while Hamas terrorists are harming the residents of Gaza and spreading lies with the purpose of blaming the State of Israel,” it added.

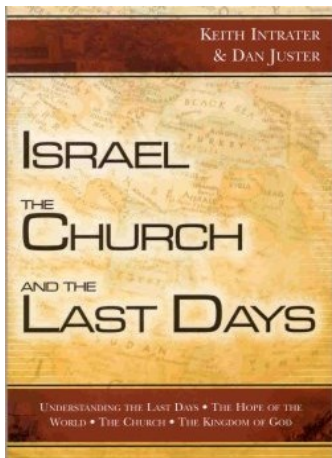
Illegal Migrant from Lebanon Admitted He’s a Hezbollah Terrorist Hoping ‘to Make a Bomb’ — and Heading for NY;

A Lebanese migrant who was caught sneaking over the border admitted he’s a member of Hezbollah, he hoped to make a bomb, and his destination was New York, American media revealed. Basel Bassel Ebbadi, 22, was caught by border patrol near El Paso, Texas. While in custody he asked what he was doing in the US, to which he replied: “I’m going to try to make a bomb,” according to a Border Patrol document exclusively obtained by the news outlet. But Ebbadi later claimed in an interview that he had been trying to flee Lebanon and Hamas because he “didn’t want to kill people” and said “Once you’re in, you can never get out,” according to internal ICE documents. Ebbadi said in a sworn interview after his arrest that he had trained with Hezbollah for seven years and served as an active member guarding weapons locations for another four years, the documents show. Ebbadi’s training focused on “jihad” and killing people “that were not Muslim,” he said. Internal documents show he was marked for deportation from the US, although it was not clear which country he would be returned to. Border agents recorded 98 encounters of terror watch-listed individuals at both the northern and southern borders in the fiscal year 2022, almost twice as many, 172, in the 2023 fiscal year which ends September 20. So far in the first months of 2024, 59 people have been apprehended, according to federal data.
